#### **Additional Topic Data**

Does the use of artificial intelligence in the military enhance strategic capabilities or does it raise ethical, legal, and security concerns? Take a stand and write on this topic.

In answering the question, remember there are no right or wrong answers. Your challenge is to describe your position, assess the pros and cons associated with it, establish, and defend it. It is critical that you relate your position to the impact it has on national security.

Find appropriate, supportive information to <u>develop your position</u>. The Air & Space Forces Association website (<u>www.AFA.org</u>), specifically, The Mitchell Institute (<u>www.mitchellaerospacepower.org</u>) and the Air Forces (<u>www.af.mil</u>) & Space Force (<u>www.spaceforce.mil</u>) may have information and articles pertaining to the topic, but you are not limited to these sources.

- Times New Roman, 12-point font
- One-Inch margins on all sides; top, left, right, and bottom
- One-half-inch header: first and last name, space, page number flush w/right margin
- Double-spaced, with the title centered on the first page
- Indent each paragraph one-half-inch
- Use correct grammar and sentence structure
- File name as specified for submission LastnameFirstname2026-Essay/Entry/PDF

Formatting and Citation: Use *MLA-9 format*. Various websites have information. Use the formatting requirements above. Numerous sites help generate citations.
