2025 – We executed over \$40,000 to military/STEM programs!

Support & Inspire Events



Supported the **645th AESS military members in Greenville, TX**, providing over \$3,000 to support their Health, Morale, and Welfare programs that included a year end party with babysitting.

Supported three **Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Squadrons** (Greenville, Rockwall, and Sulphur Springs) [*the Air Force Auxiliary*] with over \$8,100 in support to cadet programs.



Flight Simulator. Due to your generosity, we were able to purchase a flight simulator for the Greenville, TX-645 CAP squadron that will provide credit for flight hours as part of its use. This \$12,658 purchase is the first of its kind for the chapter. TX-645 is working with L3Harris to set up a permanent location for the unit with full implementation and use expected in early 2026! We expect a large return on investment for both cadet and senior leader training and are monitoring closely. We will provide more in future reports.



Educate. We put over \$16,700+ toward numerous programs. The **Greenville High School** Solar Car and their trip to Australia, three **Rockwall** CyberPatriot teams and the robotics/drone teams, and the **Sulphur Springs Elementary**, Girls Recognizing Own Worth (GROW) program. We supported the **Lone Oak** Tango Flight aircraft build program and the **Commerce High School** robotics/drones, two **Boles High School** programs. We did a first at **Hughes Springs Library** supporting two events; a robotics High School and a DNA experiment

that were well attended and highly successful. We are pleased to report that our **Chapter Teacher of the Year (TOY), Dana O'Neal**, was also the AFA Texas TOY, and that we supported her **Simms, TX**, rocket launch, CyberPatriot and StellarXplorer teams. We awarded two other TOY awards to Bryan Cole in Sulphur Springs and Isaac Frazier in Lone Oak, and supported other STEM programs at Greenville Christian School, and more.



Scholarships. \$9,700 supported ten Essay Contest scholarships and the Lt Col Larry Ratliff, Commerce HS scholarships in 2025. We recognized these winners along with our Civil Air Patrol Cadets of the Year, and our three Teachers of the Year at our Recognize & Inspire Event in March 2025. What a joy to see these wonderful recipients smile and to hear of their efforts. We could not have done this without your help!

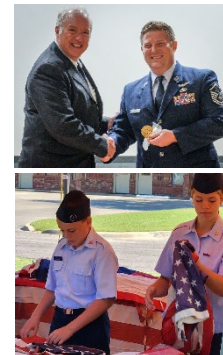

East Texas A&M, Commerce was provided with \$1000 to support their Veteran's Vigil

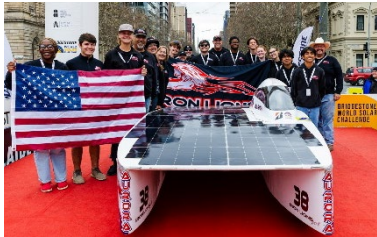
and to support their Veterans Activities.
